ASO AC (Address Council)

- NRO Number Council
- ICANN facing body
- ASO: A response to creation of ICANN (1998)
 - RIR system and Numbers communities predate ICANN
 - To connect ICANN to the already existing and fully functional system of global policy making on Numbers
 - To reflect Numbers communities views back to ICANN and make sure our mechanisims kept intact
- First MoU signed in 1999 with existing RIRs
- Current MoU is from 2004 following establishment of NRO



ASO AC (Address Council)

Scope

- Reviewing global policy development process
- Defining procedures for the selection of individuals to serve on other ICANN bodies and selecting ICANN Board seats 9 and 10.
- Providing advice to the ICANN Board on number resource allocation policy

Structure

- 15 Members [3 From Each Region]
 - 2 Elected at Large
 - 1 Appointed by RIR Board

Term in APNIC

- Two years for elected members
- One year for appointed member

ASO AC Activities: Meetings

ASO AC Activities: Global Policy Coordination

- ASO/AC does not develop policy relating to Internet number resources but rather ensures that the Policy Development Process has been correctly followed in each RIR region.
- Global policies are defined in the ASO MoU as "Internet number resource policies that have the agreement of all RIRs according to their policy development processes and ICANN, and require specific actions or outcomes on the part of IANA or any other external ICANN-related body in order to be implemented".

INTERNET GOVERNANCE **FCOSYSTEM**

Global Internet Number Resource policy is developed through a bottom-up, open, and inclusive approach. Beginning in geographic regions, issues are raised through the Regional Internet Registry (RIR) communities in the Number Resource Organization (NRO) and brought into the Address Supporting Organization (ASO). Global policies are forwarded to the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) Board of Directors and upon ratification, new policy is implemented by ICANN's Internet Assigned Numbers Authority department (IANA) working cooperatively with the RIRs and their constituencies in the respective regions.

The internet ecosystem consists of a collaborative network of organizations responsible for standardization, coordination, administration and day-to-day management in the Internet sphere including the IETF, ICANN performing the IANA function, the RIRs, governments, IGOs and NGOs, and many others. Each organization has a specific role and provides fundamental value to the

overall functioning of the Internet.

Each regional community contributes three members to the Address Council.

ARIN

RIRs administer Internet Number Resources within their geographic lacnic regions, according to defined regional policies

RIPE

The NRO represents the 5 RIRs collectively, and established the ASO by agreement with ICANN.

ASO AC

The ASO AC oversees the global policy development process for the creation of global Internet Number Resource policies, and delivers agreed policies to ICANN's Board of Directors for ratification.

Global policies must first be ratified by the RIRs. Each RIR community must ratify an identical version of the proposed policy. This policy is then forwarded by the ASO AC to the ICANN Board for ratification.

The ASO exists within the ICANN framework to oversee the policy development process for global Internet Number Resource policy.

ASC

The ASO AC appoints members to the ICANN Board, the ICANN Review , Teams, the NOMCOM and other ... ICANN bodies.
